

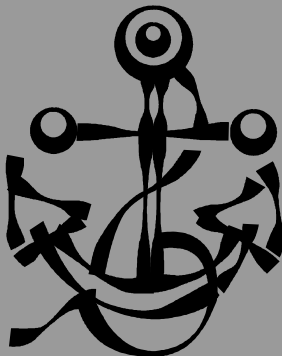

### Recipe:

#### **Asparagus Cheese Casserole**

(This is a repeat recipe, but it's s-o-o-o-o good, and asparagus is cheap right now!)

1 can asparagus tips or 1 pkg. frozen asparagus (or better yet, fresh asparagus)  
3 eggs  
salt & pepper  
1 chopped pimento (or 1 small jar chopped)  
¾ c. cracker crumbs  
1 c. cheddar, cubed or shredded  
1 c. milk  
3 T. butter

Beat eggs; add salt & pepper, crumbs, pimento, cheese & milk. Stir in asparagus (cooked if frozen or fresh). Pour into greased 1 ½ quart casserole. Melt butter & pour over top. Bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes until custard is set.
